*Let's Play Hex: Some Open Problems*

For the regular  $n \times n$  Hex board, what are some winning first moves? What about for the misere version of this game, Reverse Hex? Is the world's strongest Hexbot stronger than the world's strongest Hex human? What happens when a deterministic Hex player plays a random Hex player on a board whose shape (more rows than columns) favours the random player? What's a best strategy for Dark Hex (also known as Kriegspiel Hex, where you don't see your opponent's moves) on the  $4 \times 4$  board? I will discuss these open problems.
